In this hands-on workshop you will learn how to identify the fitting problems and how to solve them. Ron will show how to correct fitting problems regarding raising or lowering bust fullness in a princess seam, adding in a dart when a pattern requires one, moving a horizontal underarm dart to a vertical waist dart, altering for a small bust and increasing full bust for a princess seam. Along with pant alterations for knock and bowed legs, full and protruding seat, flat seat and many more. We will also take 28 body measurements for you: high bust, low bust, shoulder width, sleeve length, back waist length, pant and skirt length....plus more...a total of 28 body measurements. Every student will have an alteration package to take home with them showing all the alterations that they have done. Ron will give you the inside answer on what pattern companies run larger and which ones tend to run true to measurements. He will also explain how much wearing ease you need in all garments from close fitting, fitted, semi fitted, loose fitted and very loose fitted. Take the guess work out of trying to choose what size garment by finding the "finished garment measurements" and not using the sizes on the back of the pattern envelope. 

Scraps of cork, felt or non-fraying fabrics can be used for eyes, ears, wings, nose, feet, etc. If you use fabrics that fray, applique technique is necessary. You can use hobby eyes or button eyes.

If fraying fabric is used, applique technique is needed and best to do on your second purse.

A great insert to match your purse. If it is your favourite basic colour, you can quickly transfer your essentials from one purse to another. Non-directional fabrics are best to use on your first project to reduce seams and bulk. A sewing machine that can sew through several layers or can handle multiple jean seams is necessary. This class is useful for introduction to zippered purse pouches, bias trim and various types of pockets. Each pocket layer is interfaced and the zippered pocket is 4 layers of fabric, plus interfacings, so the assembly stage starts pushing this item into intermediate level of sewing and you need patience to sew slowly when putting layers together in the final step.
